Further to our email of 26th September 2022 regarding your request for the following information:

I am writing to request information about tunnels between AWE Aldermaston and AWE Burghfield. It is known in the Berkshire area that these exist to transport nuclear weapons and parts however I would like to know if this is just rumors.

Your request has been handled as a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (the Regulations).

Thorough searches have been carried out to locate the information you requested and we can confirm that the Atomic Weapons Establishment (AWE) does not hold any relevant information.
